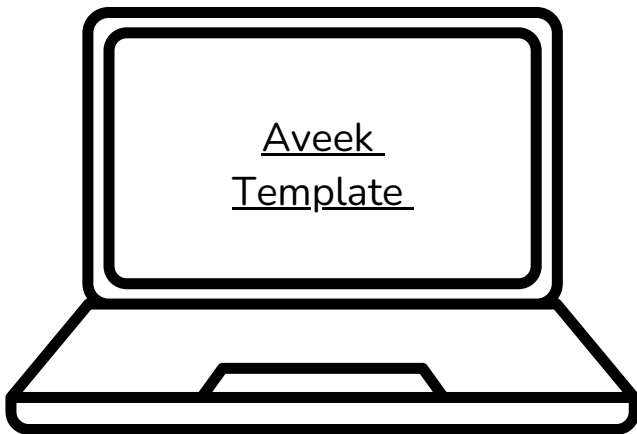
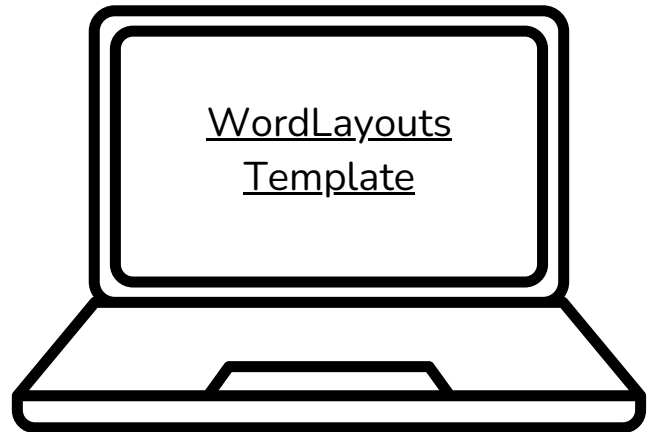
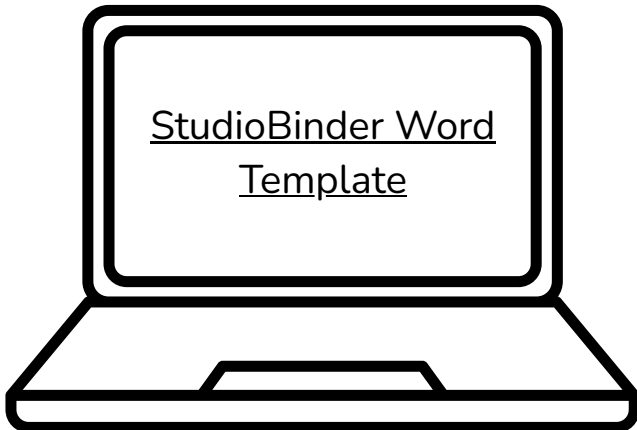
What This Pack Is For

Important Formatting Rules

- Always write in 12-point Courier font
- One page roughly equals one minute of screen time
- Scene headings (INT./EXT.) must be consistent
- Avoid dense blocks of action
- Page count accuracy matters professionally
